Notice of Force Majeure Due to Unavailability of Raw Materials

To Whom It May Concern

Dear Customer,

Littelfuse has received Force Majeure notices from suppliers, including but not limited to the notices from DuPont, Ascend, Solvay, Sabic and Almaak, concerning a shortage of raw materials. We are actively working to find out our supplier's resulting allocation decisions and determine how those allocation decisions impact our production.

Our primary goal is to support you under these circumstances to the best of our abilities and to minimize the impact on our performance. Given the multiple Force Majeure notices across our worldwide supplier base, a negative impact on our ability to supply is inevitable.

Littelfuse respectfully informs you that these circumstances constitute a Force Majeure event and render Littelfuse's performance practically and/or commercially impossible. We sincerely regret the inconvenience this causes to you. As Littelfuse has no control over these unforeseen events, it is not responsible for any damages, costs, line-downs and charges such as premium freight. However, Littelfuse will explore options to mitigate the consequences for you as our valued customer.

Please be assured that Littelfuse is paying close attention to the situation and is being sensitive to the needs of its customers. We are actively looking for available alternatives and we may approach you for urgent decision making, as we may need your support in obtaining the required approvals.

We will continue to assess the circumstances as they develop and provide updates to you when more information is available from our suppliers.
